Purpose(s):	Delivery of announcements via e-mail for the purpose of fulfilling OeNB's tasks pursuant to National Banking Act 1984 (NBG) and applicable provisions under European law as well as dispatching newsletters on different topics relating to the OeNB's tasks chosen by the data subject, including related correspondence.
Legal basis:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You have given consent to the processing of your personal data (Article 6 para. 1 lit. a GDPR). You may withdraw your consent for the processing of your personal data at any time by unsubscribing from the newsletter. Withdrawing your consent will render any future processing of your personal data unlawful. Processing in the context of announcements under public law is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the OeNB (Article 6 para. 1 lit. e GDPR): National Banking Act 1984 (NBG) and applicable provisions under European law. Processing in the context of announcements under private law is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the OeNB or by a third party (Article 6 para. 1 lit. f GDPR).
Information on the OeNB's legitimate interests:	Communication in the form of electronic announcements for the purpose of fulfilling tasks under private law.
Disclosure requirement:	If you do not provide your personal data, you will not be able to subscribe to the newsletter or receive announcements.
Information on automated decision-making, including profiling:	Does not take place.
Information on the transfer of personal data to third countries outside the EEA:	Does not take place.

2. Content of data processing activity

Here you will find information on the nature of the personal data the OeNB processes with regard to different categories of data subjects. 5. Information on your rights as a data subject

You have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not your personal data, and which of your personal data, are being processed by the OeNB (Article 15 GDPR). You have the right to obtain the rectification of inaccurate personal data or to have incomplete personal data completed (Article 16 GDPR) as long as the rectification and/or completion of the data are necessary for the purpose of the processing operation. You have the right to obtain the erasure of your personal data if the OeNB has processed them unlawfully (Article 17 GDPR). Under certain conditions, you have the right to obtain restriction of the processing of your personal data (Article 18 GDPR). Should you consider your right to data protection infringed by any processing of your personal data by the OeNB, you may lodge a complaint with the Austrian Data Protection Authority (DSB) or bring an action before the competent civil court.

6. Right to object

You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data on grounds relating to your particular situation or where personal data are processed for direct marketing purposes (Article 21 GDPR).

7. Right to withdraw consent

You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal (Article 7 para 3 GDPR).

8. Modalities for exercising your rights as a data subject

To exercise your rights as a data subject, please write to “Oesterreichische Nationalbank, Abteilung REFC/Datenschutz, Otto-Wagner-Platz 3, 1090 Vienna, AUSTRIA” or datenschutz@oenb.at. Please state in what way your personal data are subject to data processing by the OeNB, specifying the processing activity and outlining the details of your request. Moreover, please provide proof of your identity by enclosing a copy of an official photo identification (e.g. your passport, driver’s license, identity card) or using a qualified electronic signature within the meaning of Article 3 item 12 eIDAS Regulation to prevent improper requests by unauthorized third parties that might endanger the protection of your personal data. For the reasons outlined above, such requests must be made in writing.
