<b>Purpose(s) of the processing operation:</b>	Promotion of science and research by selecting, administrating, handling, documenting, monitoring and revising projects in the field of research promotion, including related correspondence, in the capacity of an Article 89 funding and promotional body pursuant to the Austrian Federal Act on General Matters pursuant to Article 89 GDPR and Research Organization (Forschungsorganisationsgesetz – FOG).
<b>Legal basis:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which you are party or in order to take steps at your request prior to entering into a contract (Article 6 para 1 lit b GDPR): research promotion contract.</li> <li>2. Processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the OeNB is subject (Article 6 para 1 lit c GDPR): Article 212 Austrian Commercial Code (Unternehmensgesetzbuch – UGB) and Article 89 GDPR in conjunction with Article 7 para 2 no 1 Austrian Data Protection Act (Datenschutzgesetz – DSG) in conjunction with Section 2 FOG, in particular Article 2d, Article 2g and Article 2j FOG.</li> </ol>
<b>Information on why the provision of personal data is required:</b>	The disclosure of data required under the provisions and regulations of the OeNB Anniversary Fund for the Promotion of Scientific Research and Teaching (Anniversary Fund) is mandatory; otherwise, applications for grants cannot be considered and funding can neither be paid out nor approved.
<b>Information on the transfer of personal data to third countries outside the EEA:</b>	Project data related to applications for funding by the OeNB Anniversary Fund may be transferred to scientific peer reviewers in third countries outside the European Economic Area (EEA). The legal basis for this data transfer is Article 89 GDPR in conjunction with Article 7 para 2 no 1 DSG in conjunction with Article 38a para 4 FOG (unless standard data protection clauses apply) or Article 46 GDPR (if standard data protection clauses apply); standard data protection clauses may be requested by sending an e-mail to <a href="mailto:fonds@oenb.at">fonds@oenb.at</a> .

## 6. Information on your rights as a data subject

To the extent that exercising your rights as a data subject does not appear to make impossible or to seriously impair the attainment of the purpose of research promotion, you have the following rights (Article 89 GDPR in conjunction with Article 7 para 2 no 1 DSG in conjunction with Article 2d para 6 FOG): You have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not your personal data, and which of your personal data, are being processed by the OeNB (Article 15 GDPR). You have the right to obtain the rectification of inaccurate personal data or to have incomplete personal data completed (Article 16 GDPR) as long as the rectification and/or completion of the data are necessary for the purpose of the processing operation. You have the right to obtain the erasure of your personal data if the OeNB has processed them unlawfully (Article 17 GDPR). Under certain conditions, you have the right to obtain restriction of the processing of your data (Article 18 GDPR). You have the right to object, on grounds relating to your particular situation, to the processing of your personal data, unless the processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out for reasons of public interest (Article 21 para 1 and para 6 GDPR). Should you consider your right to data protection infringed by any processing of your personal data by the OeNB, you may lodge a complaint with the Austrian Data Protection Authority (DSB).

## 7. Modalities for exercising your rights as a data subject

To assert your rights as a data subject, send a letter to “Oesterreichische Nationalbank, Abteilung ITS/Datenschutz, Otto-Wagner-Platz 3, 1090 Vienna, AUSTRIA” or an e-mail to [datenschutz@oenb.at](mailto:datenschutz@oenb.at). In it, state in what way your personal data are subject to data processing by the OeNB, stating the name of the data processing operation as provided on top of this form and clearly specifying the details of your request. Moreover, please provide proof of your identity by enclosing a black-and-white copy of an official photo identification (e.g. your passport, driver’s license, identity card) or using a qualified electronic signature within the meaning of Article 3 (12) eIDAS Regulation to prevent improper requests by unauthorized third parties that might endanger the protection of your personal data. For the reasons outlined above, such requests must be made in writing.
